

# Crystal Quick Reference

## Chalcopyrite

Chalcopyrite is a copper iron sulfide mineral with the chemical formula CuFeS<sub>2</sub>.

This crystal will have all the properties of copper, iron, and sulfur. It is found in Peru, Mexico, and Australia. It was first recorded by J. F. Henckel in 1725. It was named after the Greek words for copper and brass.

It removes energy blockages. This crystal also works with the chakras cleansing out negative energies, activating the chakras, and aligning them.

Chalcopyrite increases creativity. It also helps to resolve rigidness helping people to become more flexible. It also helps with being more innovative.

It also helps deal with fears of failure especially those related to poor self esteem.
